




ILLUMINATIONS



Arbor Day Foundation

Arbor Day was April 30th. Did you know the placement of trees can help you save energy? It's called "The Right Tree in the Right Place". To obtain proper placement of trees, MES has a program called Trade-A-Tree. Our certified arborist will inspect your tree to determine if it qualifies for replacement. You choose a tree to be replanted or if you prefer, have the stump removed.
